



Terms of Reference

Age Friendly Rosetown Committee Purpose

To educate, advocate and collaborate with community stakeholders to foster a community where seniors are supported to thrive and attain a high quality of life in Rosetown.

Functions

To achieve this purpose, Age Friendly Rosetown will:

1. Identify, advocate for and facilitate action for needs within the community that may benefit the quality of life for seniors;
2. Support residents/groups working to positively affect the lives of seniors in Rosetown and area. Support may be in the form of information, sharing of members' expertise, advocacy, financially or working with to attain mutual goals;
3. Serve as a place for seniors to share their concerns and ideas for improvement;
4. Celebrate seniors' contributions to the community and seek opportunities for their knowledge/experience to be shared; and
5. Share the work and principles of Age Friendly Rosetown in order to foster community recognition and trust.

Membership

- Community members who believe in the importance of supporting and celebrating seniors in Rosetown and the surrounding area.
- Seniors' participation is a priority, but residents of any age may be a member.
- Members may represent an organization, stakeholder group or as an individual as long as they comply with the Purpose of the committee.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Members
 - To uphold the purpose of the Age Friendly Rosetown Committee and those of Age Friendly Saskatchewan.
 - To be an advocate for the residents of Rosetown.
 - To positively educate and influence others about the importance of supporting and celebrating our residents.
 - To attend meetings on a regular basis and actively participate in the development and implementation of the action plans.
- Executive Members (in addition to above)
 - The Executive is comprised of the Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer.
 - To ensure Age Friendly Saskatchewan criteria is met.

- To ensure accountability on all actions to Rosetown residents and other entities where applicable.

Meetings

- Meetings are held monthly on the first Wednesday of the month.
- Notice of any cancellations or postponements will be given to members in a timely manner.
